## Workshop on Organic Farming

Date: 10.04.2023

Organic farming fosters entrepreneurship by creating opportunities for environmentally conscious individuals to establish business that align with the growing demand for organic products. Organic farming is an environment-friendly process that promotes sustainable development, labour intensive, provides healthy and nutritious food, generates income and is a source of employment.

The Department of Botany organized a one-day **Workshop on Organic Farming** at the Manipur Village, Morigaon in collaboration with Yangli Farmers Produce Company, Manipur, Morigaon on 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 under the MOU with Yangli Farmer's produce company. Altogether, around 25 students of the Department of Botany along with two faculty members of the Department were present during the Workshop which commenced in the Yangli Farmer's Producer Company premises.

The workshop commenced with a welcome speech by Mr. Janmoni Mahanta, CEO of Yangli Farmer's Producer Company who delivered a lecture on organic farming. He stressed on the use of organic procedures in farming referring to use of Vermicompost, vermiwash, Biopowder etc. He also commented on the advantages of Organic Farming and also said that they use the profits of the company to maintain a mini orchard of *Jujube* fruits employing 18 beneficiaries, particularly women. The Workshop also included on field demonstration of Vermicompost production in Manipur village and the profits extracted through the organic farming practices carried out by trained village women of Manipur village. The producers were very satisfied and encouraged by the organic farming practices as they were getting high price for their produce. The Yangli has collaborated with RGVN (Rashtriya Gramin Vikas Nidhi) to work towards **strengthening Farmer Collectives and Improving Resilience of Vulnerable Communities.**
