## International Workshop on

"Competency Development of Tertiary-Level Learners and Early-Career Researchers for Biodiversity Conservation in NE India with Reference to the UN-SDGs"

The Department of Botany, Morigaon College in collaboration with Department of Zoology and Anthropology organized a one-day international workshop on "Competency Development of Tertiary-Level Learners and Early-Career Researchers for Biodiversity Conservation in NE India with Reference to the UN-SDGs" on 24<sup>th</sup> April,2023. On this occasion Dr. Ramesh "Zimbo" Boonratana was invited as a Resource Person who is also the Regional Vice-Chair, IUCN SSC Primate Specialist Group and Editor-in-Chief, Asian Primates Journal.

Altogether more than 50 participants were present during the Workshop which included students from various Colleges of Morigaon district and faculty members. The Workshop commenced with the inauguration speech by Dr. L.K Barthakur, principal of the College followed by the welcome speech by Dr. Dhananjay Kusre, Associate Professor, Department of Zoology, Morigaon College. The Workshop kicks off with the Morigaon College song sung by the choir of Morigaon College. During this workshop Dr. Jayanta Borkakoti, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany was the Rapporteur of the Technical sessions of the day long Workshop. The resource person delivered a speech on research methodologies, funding areas of research, selecting areas of research to achieve UN-sustainable development goals(SDGs). He also spoke on brief areas of conservation of species, conservation strategies, the ecological importance of a species, and the threat of a species being eliminated from nature.

Some keynote topics of the technical sessions were divided into the following----

- 1. How to select a species for botanical or zoological research?
- 2. How to develop novel ideas for starting a research question?
- 3. How to develop funding strategies from North-East (especially Morigaon district) which can correlate with sustainable development goals?
- 4. How to design research areas on indigenous species and promote ideas for entrepreneurship development?

The students were very enlightened by the day long Workshop and the workshop ended with a Vote of thanks and distribution of certificates to the participants.
