Resolution No. 1: As a humble step towards

safeguarding the endangered languages of NE India, and preserving the linguistic heritage of Mongaon, be it resolved that an Add-on Certificate Course on "Tiwa Language" be offered by the Dept. of English to the students and the linguaphiles of Mongaon society. Be it also resolved that the proposed Add-on Course be conducted with due consultation, guidance and support from concerned language experts.

Resolution No. 2: Be it resolved that a "Syllabus Preparation Committee" for offering the Add-on Certificate Course on Tiwa Language be constituted with Dr. Ajit Konwar, Asst Professor of the Department; and Dr. Bidyut Bishnu Senapati, Gen Secy, Tiwa Matronlai Tokhra and Tiwa language experts. A REPORT on National Webinar on "Eco Criticism and Covid 19 Pandemic: A Literary Survey"

Organised by Dept. of English

Morigaon College

A National Webinar on "Eco Criticism and Covid 19 Pandemic: A Literary Survey" was organized by the Dept. of English, Morigaon College on 6 July, 2021. Dr. Lila Kanta Barthakur, Principal, Morigaon College inaugurated the webinar and delivered the welcome address. The webinar addressed pertinent issues of immediate concern. Dr. Ratan Bhattacharjee, Trilingual Poet, Novelist and Columnist; Associate Professor and Head, Post Graduate Dept. of English, Dum Dum Motijheel College, Kolkata graced the webinar as the invited speaker. In his invaluable deliberation, Dr. Bhattacharjee emphasized on the need to connect human lives with nature. He analysed different literary works across continents that represent the interactions between man and nature from Boccaccio to Chaucer, Shakespeare, Wordsworth, Shelley, Tennyson, Hardy, Whitman, Tagore and others. The literary representations of benevolence vs. malevolence of nature; physical nature vs. man made nature; the shaping of nature by man through activities like agriculture, mining, constructions etc. and their repercussions, formed the core of his presentation. He laid bare the paradox that lies behind man's effort at conservation of nature through texts like Shakespeare's *Tempest* and Wordsworth's "Upon Westminster Bridge". Dr. Bhattacharjee also talked of the ideal situation of the 'Ecotopia' where every living creature would be treated equally. Speaking of the current Covid 19 pandemic, the speaker contextualized the role of literature as a body of evidential statements testifying to the variegated catastrophe befalling human lives and the human attempts made at overcoming them. The interaction session was animated owing to the active involvement of participants from every nook and corner of the country. Around 273 participants attended the webinar which was conducted on Google meet; made live on YouTube and is available in the official YouTube Channel of Morigaon College (Media Centre Morigaon College). Prof. Jogen Chandra Kalita, President, Governing Body, Morigaon

College and Head, Dept. of Zoology, Gauhati University congratulated the organizers and exhorted them to undertake more such activities in future. The Coordinator of the webinar, Dr. Saradashree Choudhury, Assistant Professor of English, Morigaon College moderated the session. Dr. Diganta Kumar Nath, Head, Dept. of English, Morigaon College offered the vote of thanks. Mr. Bulbul Das, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Computer Applications and Mr. Partha Pratim Bordoloi, Office Assistant played a pivotal role in the handling of technical issues. Notwithstanding the dark clouds of the pandemic, the webinar ended on a note of optimism, "If winter comes/ Can spring be far behind?"
