**Concept Note:** Literature from Northeast India includes both the literature in the languages from the region and the body of work of the writers writing in English. The writers here have been deeply concerned with numerous socio-political issues. The issues have pushed the writers towards unique materials and trends of their literary writing. The writers have been able to strike a splendid balance between a violent past of militarism, militancy, troublesome predicaments and relatively a peaceful state of existence in which the communities have started of dreaming a calm, tranquil and progressive life. It is against this backdrop that literature of Northeast India has been struck with mixed issues like incredible natural beauty, multiplicity of culture, ethnic communities, insurgency, political factionalism, a sense of alienation etc. The workshop provides an ample scope to the participants for understanding the implications of the writings on these issues from the region.
