

organised by Department of English, Morigaon College

#### Concept Note:

Literary and cultural theories have increasingly claimed cultural centrality for narrative. The theory of narrative has been an active branch of literary theory, and literary study relies on theories of narrative structure: on notions of plot, of different kinds of narrators, of narrative techniques. The poetics of narrative, as we might call it, both attempts to understand the components of narrative and analyses how a particular narrative achieves its effects. Keeping such a notion in mind the Workshop is organized for the greater benefit of the student community.

- \* To make the students aware of the benefit of narrative writing in its literary application
