Concept Note:

Gender refers to the characteristics of women, men, girls and boys that are socially constructed. This includes norms, behaviors and roles associated with being a woman, man, girl or boy, as well as relationship with each other. As a social construct, gender varies from society to society, from culture to culture and from time to time. At the same time gender theory is the study of what is understood as masculine or feminine and queer behavior in any given context, community or area of research and study. Gender studies through literature also aim to understand how society and culture influence our idea of what it means to be a man or a woman in various contexts. This workshop is an attempt for such a study on gender.

- * To make the students aware of the theories on gender discrimination, disparity and other gender issues
- * To make them free from gender biasness and prejudice

The workshop was conducted free of cost to the students and it was organised with available Resource persons and infrastructure in the college.

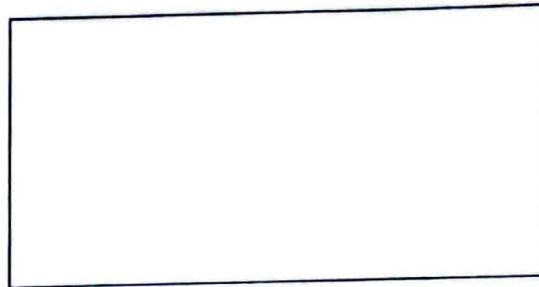
